

## House Resolution No. 4794

**Whereas**, it is with special pleasure that the members of the Missouri House of Representatives pause to recognize the Lincoln County Sheriff's Department for the many contributions they have made to the safety and protection of the residents of Lincoln County; and

**Whereas**, the Lincoln County Sheriff's Department has an impressive staff that includes thirty-five deputies, all of whom receive thirty minutes of training each day; twenty-five correction officers; twenty support staff; and twenty dispatchers, all of whom are trained to prioritize calls, which reduces response time for emergencies; and

**Whereas**, the Lincoln County Sheriff's Department also has six officers who perform D.A.R.E. programs and other educational programs at local schools; and

**Whereas**, every employee at the Lincoln County Sheriff's Department is trained in CPR and the use of defibrillators, which are found in each patrol car and in all the local public schools; and

**Whereas**, the Lincoln County Jail was built in 1996 and is capable of housing 160 prisoners, all of whom are taken out on work details to either pick-up trash or cut weeds each Saturday; and

**Whereas**, the Lincoln County Sheriff's Department uses no general revenue money from Lincoln County, but relies on sales tax and funds from housing prisoners from other counties; and

**Whereas**, special words of commendation go out to Lincoln County Sheriff Daniel Torres, who has successfully completed the many duties and tasks placed before him as Sheriff for the past three years:

**Now, therefore, be it resolved** that we, the members of the Missouri House of Representatives, Ninety-second General Assembly, unanimously join in expressing our utmost appreciation to all those dedicated individuals affiliated with the Lincoln County Sheriff's Department for the unparalleled service they have rendered to the citizenry of Lincoln County, and in wishing them only the very best as they continue to make a difference in the lives of those they've vowed to serve and protect; and
