1 AMEND House Bill No. 48, Page 1, In the Title, Lines 2 and 3, by  
2 deleting all of said lines and inserting in lieu thereof the  
3 following:

4 "To repeal sections 144.518 and 184.357, RSMo, and to enact  
5 in lieu thereof three new sections relating to museum and  
6 tourism-related activities, with an emergency clause."; and

7 Further amend said bill, Page 1, Section A, Lines 1 and 2,  
8 by deleting all of said lines and inserting in lieu thereof the  
9 following:

10 "Section A. Sections 144.518 and 184.357, RSMo, are  
11 repealed and three new sections enacted in lieu thereof, to be  
12 known as sections 82.520, 144.518, and 184.357, to read as  
13 follows."; and

14 Further amend said bill, Page 4, Section 82.850, Line 124,  
15 by inserting after all of said line the following:

16 "184.357. 1. The board of directors of any metropolitan

1 zoological park and museum district as established pursuant to  
2 the provisions of sections 184.350 to 184.384, on behalf of the  
3 district, may request the election officials of any city and  
4 county of such district to submit a proposition or propositions  
5 to increase the tax rate for the zoological park subdistrict and  
6 the art museum subdistrict set in section 184.350 and to increase  
7 the rate for the botanical garden subdistrict set in section  
8 184.353 to the qualified voters of such district at any general,  
9 primary or special election. Such election officials, upon  
10 receipt of such request in the form of a verified resolution or  
11 resolutions approved by the majority of the members of such  
12 district board of directors, shall set the date of such election  
13 and give notice of such election as provided by sections 115.063  
14 and 115.065, RSMo.

15 2. Such proposition or propositions shall be jointly or  
16 severally submitted to the voters in substantially the following  
17 form at such election:

18 (1) Shall the Metropolitan Zoological Park and Museum  
19 District of the City of ..... and County of ..... be  
20 authorized to increase the tax rate for the zoological park  
21 subdistrict up to the maximum tax rate of eight cents, or any  
22 percent thereof, on each \$100 of assessed valuation of taxable  
23 property within the district for the purpose of operating,  
24 maintaining and otherwise financially supporting the subdistrict?

1 The tax rate shall be set annually by the board based on the  
2 budget submitted by the zoological park subdistrict and approved  
3 by the board. This tax rate shall replace the present tax rate  
4 of ..... cents for the zoological park subdistrict.

6 (2) Shall the Metropolitan Zoological Park and Museum  
7 District of the City of ..... and County of ..... be  
8 authorized to increase the tax rate for the art museum  
9 subdistrict up to the maximum tax rate of eight cents, or any  
10 percent thereof, on each \$100 of assessed valuation of taxable  
11 property within the district for the purpose of operating,  
12 maintaining and otherwise financially supporting the subdistrict  
13 and approved by the board? The tax rate shall be set annually by  
14 the board based on the budget submitted by the art museum  
15 subdistrict and approved by the board. This tax rate shall  
16 replace the present tax rate of ..... cents for the art museum  
17 subdistrict.

11 museum subdistrict up to the maximum tax rate of six cents, or  
12 any percent thereof, on each \$100 of assessed valuation of  
13 taxable property within the district for the purpose of  
14 operating, maintaining, and otherwise financially supporting the  
15 subdistrict and approved by the board? The tax rate shall be set  
16 annually by the board based on the budget submitted by the  
17 Missouri history museum subdistrict and approved by the board.  
18 This tax rate shall replace the present tax rate of ..... cents  
19 for the Missouri history museum subdistrict.

22 In the event that a majority of the voters voting on such  
23 proposition or propositions in such city and the majority of the  
24 voters voting on such proposition or propositions in such county

1 cast votes "YES" on the proposition or propositions, then the tax  
2 rate for such subdistrict shall be deemed in full force and  
3 effect as of the first day of the second month following the  
4 election. The results of the aforesaid election shall be  
5 certified by the election officials of such city and county,  
6 respectively, to the respective chief executive officers of such  
7 city and county not less than thirty days after the day on which  
8 such election was held. The cost of the election shall be paid  
9 as provided by sections 115.063 and 115.065, RSMo. In the event  
10 the proposition or propositions shall fail to receive a majority  
11 of the votes "YES" in either the city or the county, then the  
12 proposition or propositions shall not be resubmitted at any  
13 election held within one year of the date of the election the  
14 proposition or propositions were rejected."; and

15 Further amend said title, enacting clause and intersectional  
16 references accordingly.
