Whereas, Sheila Gassner is the beloved daughter of Edwin and Pauline Stagemen and the loving wife of Joe Gassner; and

Whereas, serving as a focus in the fight against abandoning and destroying an area's historical, social, and educational significance, Sheila Gassner will receive a prestigious Preserve Missouri Award in the area of industrial rehabilitation from Missouri Preservation (the Missouri Alliance for Historic Preservation) at a special awards ceremony to be held in the State Capitol Rotunda on Wednesday, February 23, 2005:
