

## House Resolution No. 571

**Whereas**, from time to time the members of the Missouri House of Representatives are called upon to recognize the meritorious endeavors of outstanding Missourians, a task which this legislative body embraces with great enthusiasm; and

**Whereas**, Jacques Sachs, a resident of Springfield, Missouri, is retiring from his position as a Board member with TelComm Credit Union, formerly known as Springfield Telephone Employees Credit Union, following fifty-two years of volunteer service; and

**Whereas**, elected to the Supervisory Committee in October 1953, Jacques Sachs was elected to the Board of Directors in October 1959, Vice President in October 1978, and President in 1981, a position he held until 1993; and

**Whereas**, during Jacques Sachs' impressive tenure, Springfield Telephone Employees Credit Union merged with Hoffman Taft Credit Union in 1983 and Springday Credit Union in 1987; and

**Whereas**, Jacques Sachs played an instrumental role in organizing the Missouri Telephone Credit Union Council and in helping Springfield Telephone Employees Credit Union become the first free-standing credit union to have its own facility separate from the Sponsoring Employee Group in southern Missouri; and

**Whereas**, in 2000, Jacques Sachs voted with all the Board to convert Springfield Telephone Employees Credit Union to a community credit union and a name change to TelComm Credit Union, which was approved by the state of Missouri; and

**Whereas**, Jacques Sachs has been blessed with the love and support of a wonderful family whose members include his wife, Lucille; and four children, Lucy Kawaihalau of Kauai, Hawaii, Linda McMurry of Paragould, Arkansas, Jacques B. Sachs of Salem, Missouri, and Janine Sachs of Springfield, Missouri:

**Now, therefore, be it resolved** that we, the members of the Missouri House of Representatives, Ninety-third General Assembly, join unanimously in expressing deep gratitude for the superb service that Jacques Sachs has rendered to TelComm Credit Union during the past fifty-two years and in wishing him ample opportunity to enjoy the better things life has to offer; and

**Be it further resolved** that the Chief Clerk of the Missouri House of Representatives be instructed to prepare a properly inscribed copy of this resolution for Jacques Sachs, as a measure of our esteem for him.
