Whereas, serving as a focus in the fight against abandoning and destroying an area's historical, social, and educational significance, Scott Shader will receive the prestigious Osmund Overby Award from Missouri Preservation (the Missouri Alliance for Historic Preservation) at a special awards ceremony to be held in the State Capitol Rotunda on Wednesday, February 23, 2005:
