

## House Resolution No. 1111

**Whereas**, the members of the Missouri House of Representatives hold in high esteem those Show-Me State athletic programs which embody the highest standards of sportsmanship, training, determination, and drive throughout the competitive season; and

**Whereas**, the Richmond High School wrestling team led by Head Coach John Daniels and Assistant Coach Daniel Dunkin attained considerable distinction during the 2004-2005 school year in Class 1 Missouri State High School Activities Association sanctioned events; and

**Whereas**, from February 17 to February 19, 2005, Richmond High School wrestlers enhanced their already impressive record of achievement by having eleven wrestlers participate in the State Championships in the Hearnes Center on the beautiful and historic University of Missouri-Columbia campus; and

**Whereas**, in competition with two hundred thirteen other Class 1 athletes, the Richmond High School wrestlers took First Place as a team with an overall score of 141.5; and

**Whereas**, senior Ryan Lauck took First in the 189 pound weight class, senior Brandon Simpson took First at 160 pounds, sophomore Morgan Brown took First at 119 pounds, sophomore Cody Hogan took Third at 103 pounds, senior Scott Peck took Fourth at 140 pounds, senior Justin Stevenson took Fifth at 125 pounds, and junior Kris Warren took Sixth at 171 pounds; and

**Whereas**, the Richmond High School wrestling team also had several students who gained invaluable experience at State but did not place, including 112 pound freshman Jordan Adkins, 275 pound freshman Zane Fields, 130 pound senior Brad Richardson, and 152 pound sophomore Jay Jackson; and

**Whereas**, it is fitting and proper that the Missouri House of Representatives should pause in its diverse legislative endeavors in order to give glory, honor, and tribute to such an outstanding athletic team as the Champion Richmond High School wrestlers:

**Now, therefore, be it resolved** that we, the members of the Missouri House of Representatives, Ninety-third General Assembly, join unanimously to applaud the impressive accomplishments garnered by the wrestlers of Richmond High School and to convey to all of those involved this legislative body's most heartfelt best wishes for continued personal, academic, and athletic success for many more years to come; and
