Whereas, the members of the Missouri House of Representatives hold in high esteem those Show-Me State medical professionals who have admirably helped improve the quality of life in local communities and neighborhoods through their dedication to the field of medicine and their entrepreneurial spirit in the field of business; and

Whereas, Cape Family Practice is a family medicine clinic which has been in operation since 1963; and

Whereas, on Friday, March 4, 2005, a ribbon cutting will take place at the new Cape Family Practice facility whose construction was begun in May 2004 and completed in February 2005; and

Whereas, the new Cape Family Practice building is owned by Jerry Keele, Dr. Anthony Keele, and Dr. Lori Moyers who are doing business under the company name of AJL Investments, LLC; and

Whereas, Dr. Anthony Keele and Dr. Lori Moyers are joined in their family medicine practice by Dr. Thomas Sparkman, who is the longest practicing physician in Cape Girardeau history, and by nurse practitioner Debbie Evans; and

Whereas, Cape Family Practice underwent incorporation in July 2003 through the partnership of Dr. Anthony Keele and Dr. Lori Moyers; and

Whereas, in addition to Cape Family Practice, the newly constructed building at 1417 North Mount Auburn Road in Cape Girardeau will house other businesses:
