WHEREAS, Clifford Moulton responded to a Code 16 (medical emergency) radio call to help restrain an inmate who was lying on the floor of his cell and bleeding profusely; and

WHEREAS, Clifford Moulton helped remove the offender from the cell to provide space for medical responders and then helped load him on a stretcher for transport to the medical unit; and

WHEREAS, the quick, astute, and highly professional actions of Clifford Moulton played a crucial role in saving a fellow human's life; and

WHEREAS, initially hired by the Missouri Department of Corrections on March 11, 2003, Clifford Moulton is justifiably proud to be known as a high school graduate who subsequently answered the patriotic call to national service through his enlistment in the United States military:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that we, the members of the Missouri Senate, Ninety-third General Assembly, join unanimously to commend the diverse professional activities of Clifford Moulton, to convey to him this legislative body's heartiest congratulations upon his selection for a Department of Corrections Lifesaver Award, and to express our sincerest best wishes for continued personal and professional success for many more years to come; and
