**Whereas**, the members of the Missouri House of Representatives take tremendous pleasure in recognizing those governmental employees who have brought honor to the Show-Me State through their professionalism and willingness to intervene in life-threatening situations; and

**Whereas**, Corrections Officer I Rebecca Caldwell of Center, Missouri, will be awarded the Missouri Department of Corrections Lifesaver Award during ceremonies to be held on March 24, 2005, at the Northeast Correctional Center in Bowling Green; and

**Whereas**, on June 2, 2004, several Corrections Officers from the Northeast Correctional Center came upon a horrific car accident on Highway 61 near Bowling Green; and

**Whereas**, Corrections Classification Assistant Brook Kurth went to the aid of a six-year-old boy who had been thrown out of his families vehicle and going into shock, while Officer Randy Graddy went to the aide of a nine-year-old boy suffering from the same fate; and

**Whereas**, Officer Darrell Harrison responded to the mother of the family who had also been ejected from the vehicle and assisted Emergency Medical Technicians in placing the woman on a stretcher; and

**Whereas**, Officer Ronald Denler climbed into the smashed vehicle through its rear window to tend to the driver, the father of the family, who had suffered severe head trauma and was trapped inside; and

**Whereas**, Officer Rebecca Caldwell attended to an eleven-year-old girl who had also been thrown from the vehicle and was drifting in and out of consciousness due to head injuries sustained in the accident; and

**Whereas**, Rebecca Caldwell's dedication to her profession, her ability to remain calm in a stressful situation, and her competence to react with sound judgement utilizing skills learned in Department training helped save the life of others; and

**Whereas**, the daughter of Eddie C. and Margaret Caldwell of Perry, Rebecca Caldwell has been blessed with the love and support of a wonderful family whose members include her children, Larry Dean Johnson of Colorado Springs, Colorado, and Cindy Deener of Perry; and seven grandchildren:

**Now, therefore, be it resolved** that we, the members of the Missouri House of Representatives, Ninety-second General Assembly, join unanimously to applaud the training and practices of CO I Rebecca Caldwell and to congratulate her upon his well-deserved selection to receive the Department of Corrections Lifesaver Award; and

**Be it further resolved** that the Chief Clerk of the Missouri House of Representatives be instructed to prepare a properly inscribed copy of this resolution for Corrections Officer Rebecca Caldwell, as a measure of our esteem for her.
