

House Resolution No. 1114

Whereas, the members of the Missouri House of Representatives hold in high esteem those Show-Me State high school athletes who admirably demonstrate the highest standards of sportsmanship, training, perseverance, and drive; and

Whereas, Tim Cornell of Columbia, Missouri, has attained considerable distinction as a member of the senior class at Hickman High School and a dedicated runner on the Class 4 cross country team; and

Whereas, on Saturday, November 6, 2004, Tim Cornell enhanced his already impressive record of accomplishments when he took First Place in the Missouri State High School Activities Association sanctioned state championship meet which was held at Oak Hills Golf Center in Jefferson City; and

Whereas, Tim Cornell's time of sixteen minutes, twenty-one seconds, was a full four seconds ahead of the second-place challenger from Marquette High School and thirteen seconds quicker than the third-place runner from Parkway South High School; and

Whereas, the First Place individual finish of Tim Cornell paved the way for the Hickman Kewpies to place fifth as a team with an aggregate time of 1:26:32.51 and a team average of 17:18.50; and

Whereas, skillfully guided by Coach Steve Kissane, Tim Cornell's First Place finish at the 2004 cross country meet gave him his second State Champion title in two years; and

Whereas, Tim Cornell earned First Place in 2003 with a time of sixteen minutes, one second:

Now, therefore, be it resolved that we, the members of the Missouri House of Representatives, Ninety-third General Assembly, join unanimously to applaud the impressive athleticism of Tim Cornell and to convey to him this legislative body's most heartfelt congratulations upon taking First Place in the 2004 Class 4 cross country state championship meet in Jefferson City; and
