**Whereas**, Crime Stoppers is a community program which provides citizens with an anonymous way to report crimes and suspicious activities; and

**Whereas**, on January 22, 2003, Donald Garrison heard a car alarm going off on a vehicle parked on Kingshighway at Fielding Street; and

**Whereas**, Donald Garrison witnessed an individual near a yellow hummer with a broken window and yelled at him to stop, which resulted in the suspect fleeing the scene; and

**Whereas**, Donald Garrison followed the suspect north down an alley between Houston and Kingshighway and observed the suspect get into an older model Chevrolet with Missouri license plates, which he reported to police which lead to the arrest of two suspects responsible for approximately 15 vehicle break-ins; and

**Whereas**, it is entirely fitting and proper that this legislative body should pay tribute to Donald Garrison, a remarkable individual whose efforts and willingness to cooperate were of tremendous help to local law enforcement:

**Now, therefore, be it resolved** that we, the members of the Missouri House of Representatives, Ninety-third General Assembly, unanimously join in extending our most hearty and robust congratulations to Donald Garrison at this proud moment of well-deserved distinction; and
