

## House Resolution No. 1799

**Whereas**, the members of the Missouri House of Representatives hold in high esteem those patriotic Show-Me State organizations which admirably provide additional service venues for those individuals who have answered the call to national service through enlistment in the various branches of the United States military; and

**Whereas**, Veterans of Foreign Wars Post #4233 in Lemay, Missouri, was founded on July 12, 1945, with its related Auxiliary formed on August 19, 1946; and

**Whereas**, on May 1, 2005, the VFW Post and Auxiliary #4233 will hold a Loyalty Day to emphasize patriotism and to honor veterans, the current ranks of men and women in military service, the American flag, and our great country; and

**Whereas**, with Post membership standing at sixty-six and the Auxiliary at fifty-seven, VFW Post and Auxiliary #4233 are justifiably proud of their support for veterans hospitals, the USO, and the National Home for Children which cares for orphans; and

**Whereas**, VFW Post and Auxiliary #4233 provide assistance for veterans who need help in getting a pension, compensation benefits, housing, education, health screenings, employment, or loans for small businesses; and

**Whereas**, VFW Post and Auxiliary #4233 support current troops by sending packages and phone cards; and

**Whereas**, in addition to supplying financial grants to cancer victims, VFW Post and Auxiliary #4233 donate flags for use by schools, convents, and other worthy institutions; and

**Whereas**, it is fitting and proper that the Missouri House of Representatives should pause in its diverse legislative endeavors in order to recognize such exemplary organizations as VFW Post and Auxiliary #4233 at momentous times in their histories:
