Whereas, Nancy Greeley was honored as one of only twelve outstanding principals in Missouri by the Missouri Association of Elementary and Secondary Principals during the organization's annual conference held March 20, 2005, at Tan-Tar-A in Lake Ozark; and

Whereas, Nancy Greeley has served as the Principal at West Nodaway Elementary School for the past five years, during which time she has earned the praise and respect of her colleagues for her ability to nurture, listen, and to step aside to let new leaders emerge on her staff; and

Whereas, Nancy Greeley began her career in education as a kindergarten teacher at West Nodaway Elementary School twenty-four years ago, and served the Nodaway-Holt School as an elementary principal for eight years before returning to West Nodaway Elementary School as its principal in 2000; and
