Whereas, after furthering her education at a Saint Joseph junior college and at Central Methodist College, Doris Franklin returned to Savannah to serve as clerk of the Probate/Magistrate Court for Joy Mitchell; and

Whereas, Doris Franklin married Perry Franklin on January 11, 1953, and subsequently moved to Sabetha, Kansas; co-owned a lumberyard for eleven years; worked in the accounting department for Wenger Manufacturing; and became active in the Nemaha County Republican Women's Club; and

Whereas, Doris Franklin returned to Savannah in 1979, became active in the Andrew County Republican Women's Club and served as its secretary, enjoyed election to two terms as Andrew County Treasurer, and retired; and

Whereas, it is fitting and proper that the Missouri House of Representatives should acknowledge lifetime achievements by such outstanding citizens as Doris Franklin:

Now, therefore, be it resolved that we, the members of the Missouri House of Representatives, Ninety-third General Assembly, join unanimously to applaud the civic-minded endeavors of Doris Franklin in both elective and volunteer service venues and to convey to her this legislative body's most heartfelt best wishes for continued personal and professional success for many more years to come; and
