

House Resolution No. 2968

Whereas, the members of the Missouri House of Representatives always welcome the opportunity to recognize young men who have excelled during their association with the Boy Scouts of America program with its emphasis on physical, mental, and spiritual growth; self-reliance; personal values; service to others; and an appreciation and understanding of the wonderful natural world; and

Whereas, Matthew Melly of Troop 21 has successfully completed all of the stringent requirements for Scouting's highest advancement award, the rank of Eagle Scout, which will be bestowed upon him during an Eagle Court of Honor on May 24, 2005, at Clayton High School in Clayton, Missouri; and

Whereas, attainment of the Eagle Scout rank is dependent upon the sequential completion of each of the Boy Scout steps of Tenderfoot, Second Class, First Class, Star, and Life, and expected troop service, a requirement admirably fulfilled by Matthew through the billet of Instructor; and

Whereas, diligent labors by Matthew earned him induction into the Order of the Arrow and twenty-one merit badges which are arrayed on his uniform sash as a visual illustration of the diverse skills and knowledge which he has acquired as a Boy Scout; and

Whereas, in keeping with Scouting practice, Matthew applied the knowledge which he learned at troop meetings in many camping, hiking, and service activities, including a rigorous trek through Philmont Scout Ranch near Cimarron, New Mexico, during 2001 and a trip to southern New Mexico in 2002; and

Whereas, Matthew completed an Eagle Project which consisted of building retaining walls for Saint Andrew Kim Parish in University City, Missouri, to serve as a capstone to his Scouting career and to stand as a constant reminder of his dedication to serving others, an admirable trait which justifies the esteemed role which Scouting plays in today's society:

Now, therefore, be it resolved that we, the members of the Missouri House of Representatives, Ninety-third General Assembly, join unanimously to applaud the outstanding achievements realized by Matthew Melly during his eleven-year-long sojourn with Scouting and to congratulate him for having the drive and energy necessary to attain the rank of Eagle; and

Be it further resolved that the Chief Clerk of the Missouri House of Representatives be instructed to prepare a properly inscribed copy of this resolution for new Eagle Scout Matthew Melly, son of Jeff and Sandy Melly of Clayton, Missouri.
