

## House Resolution No.

**Whereas**, the Greater Lake Area Arts Council supports a number of local artistic venues, including Student Art Quest, Junior Duck Stamp, Lake Area Photo Club, Photo Quest, Lake Area Performing Arts Guild, National Oil and Acrylic Painters Society, Lake of the Ozarks Writers Guild, Lake Area Strings, Lake Area Chorale, Lake Area Community Orchestra, Mini Organ and Piano Concerts, and Ozark Jazz Society; and

**Whereas**, the Greater Lake Area Arts Council takes as its mission to serve, educate, and enrich communities through the arts; and

**Whereas**, it is fitting and proper that the Missouri House of Representatives should pause in their diverse legislative endeavors in order to recognize such outstanding artistic organizations as the Greater Lake Area Arts Council:

**Now, therefore, be it resolved** that we, the members of the Missouri House of Representatives, Ninety-third General Assembly, join unanimously to welcome the Greater Lake Area Arts Council to the Missouri state capitol and to convey to it this legislative body's most heartfelt best wishes for continued success for many more years to come; and
