**Whereas**, Jeretta Hardison has been blessed with the love and support of a wonderful family whose members include her husband, William Gary Hardison; two children, Leslie Joyce of Nazareth, Pennsylvania, and Gregg of York, Pennsylvania; and give grandchildren:
