**Whereas**, Stephanie Sechler of Willard has attained considerable distinction as the daughter of Brent and Michelle Sechler and as a student at Willard Middle School; and

**Whereas**, Stephanie Sechler enhanced her already impressive record of accomplishments when she attended the Junior National Young Leaders Conference in Washington D.C. from July 3 to July 8, 2004; and

**Whereas**, sponsored by the Congressional Youth Leadership Council, the Junior National Young Leaders Conference in 2004 was themed “The Legacy of American Leadership” and introduced young people to the rich tradition of leadership throughout American history, especially the periods of the Civil War and Reconstruction, the Great Depression, World War II, and the Civil Rights Movement; and
