

House Resolution No. 3767

Whereas, the members of the Missouri House of Representatives hold in high esteem those Show-Me State educational institutions which bring glory and honor to themselves and to this great state through the excellence of their achievements, goals, and programs; and

Whereas, Lincoln University of Jefferson City, Missouri, has attained considerable distinction since its founding as a state institution for higher education in 1866, through its 1890 land-grant status, and by its participation in the Missouri Cooperative Extension Program; and

Whereas, on June 17, 2005, Lincoln University will enhance its already impressive record of accomplishments when it opens an Urban Outreach Center in Saint Louis to serve as a “change agent” enhancing individual development and empowering the community by addressing the physical, social, and economic needs of underserved and underrepresented populations; and

Whereas, the new Lincoln University Urban Outreach Center will offer Youth Development, After-School Care, Community Development, Resource Management for Families, Financial Literacy, Computer Literacy, Educational Services, and Life Skills programs; and

Whereas, the Urban Outreach Center in Saint Louis will broaden the scope and depth of programs currently offered by Lincoln University’s main campus in Jefferson City and other locations in Kansas City and the Bootheel region of southeast Missouri; and

Whereas, the Urban Outreach Center in Saint Louis will be open Monday through Friday with a majority of its products and services provided free of charge and with workshop times which will vary depending upon the audience, location, and partnership agreement:

Now, therefore, be it resolved that we, the members of the Missouri House of Representatives, Ninety-third General Assembly, join unanimously to applaud the accomplishments garnered thus far in the stellar history of Lincoln University and to convey to all of those involved this legislative body’s most heartfelt congratulations upon the opening of the new Urban Outreach Center on Riverview Drive in Saint Louis; and

Be it further resolved that the Chief Clerk of the Missouri House of Representatives be instructed to prepare a properly inscribed copy of this resolution for presentation at the grand opening of the Lincoln University Urban Outreach Center in Saint Louis, Missouri.
