

House Resolution No. 4061

Whereas, the members of the Missouri House of Representatives hold in tremendous esteem those young Show-Me State residents who have bettered themselves and their communities through the challenges and opportunities available to them in the Boy Scouts of America program; and

Whereas, Donald Lee “DJ” McConville of Troop 300 entered Scouting eight years ago, since which time he has continued on his illustrious sojourn by completing all of the requirements for the Tenderfoot, Second Class, First Class, Star, and Life ranks and by serving his Troop in such leadership posts as Patrol Leader, Assistant Patrol Leader, Troop Guide, Den Chief, Quartermaster, and Patrol Scribe; and

Whereas, DJ is a member of Order of the Arrow who participated in such outdoor experiences as three summer camps at H. Roe Bartle Scout Reservation and annual Camporees; and

Whereas, DJ earned the World Conservation Award, Snorkeling patch, and CPR certification; and

Whereas, in addition to fulfilling the requirements for thirty-three Merit Badges, DJ followed through with the Scouting tradition of completing an Eagle Project by constructing four fish habitats from 4x4 wooden beams with thirty to forty vertical stakes attached and then anchoring them in place with cinder blocks in order to benefit fish by offering a place for concealment and to benefit fishermen by increasing the total number of fish that reach maturity in the lake; and

Whereas, DJ will receive his well-deserved Eagle Medallion at a Court of Honor on Sunday, September 19, 2004, at Pleasant Hill United Methodist Church:
