**Whereas**, the members of the Missouri House of Representatives pause to recognize Holden Intermediate School in Holden, Missouri, which will celebrate the completion of its new building with a special event to be held October 3, 2004; and

**Whereas**, the new building will provide the technology infrastructure needed in today's classrooms, as well as spacious, air-conditioned classrooms throughout the school; and

**Whereas**, a \$1 million grant was secured by the Johnson County Commission for a new school building from Associated Electrical Cooperative, Inc. when they built an electrical power plant north of town in 1999-2000; and

**Whereas**, following the completion of the power plant and funds were received, school officials held on to the money to make sure it went toward a construction project; and

**Whereas**, the \$1 million fund, coupled with SB781 funding, allowed the Holden School District to propose a construction plan without a tax increase; and

**Whereas**, special words of commendation go out to the members of the school board, Parent Teacher Organization, Boosters, and others for their efforts to build community support for the bond issue, which passed with seventy percent approval by Holden voters; and

**Whereas**, the school board and school community appreciate the many fond memories that Holden students have from the old Intermediate School building, which has served grades 4-12, and look forward to beginning new memories in this new state-of-the-art facility:

**Now, therefore, be it resolved** that we, the members of the Missouri House of Representatives, Ninety-second General Assembly, unanimously join in extending our most hearty congratulations to all those dedicated individuals affiliated with the construction of the new Holden Intermediate School at this proud moment of well-deserved distinction; and

**Be it further resolved** that the Chief Clerk of the Missouri House of Representatives be instructed to prepare a properly inscribed copy of this resolution in honor of Holden Intermediate School in Holden, Missouri.
