Whereas, after a series of poor decisions resulted in the destruction of the 1989 Chevrolet Silverado that he cherished, Jacob Highfill developed a greater appreciation for his life, family, friends, and possessions; and

Whereas, Jacob Highfill is the son of Dean and Sandy Highfill of Ozark and Sheryl and Robert Cook of Springfield and is the older sibling of Sarah "Little Jake" Highfill:

Now, therefore, be it resolved that we, the members of the Missouri House of Representatives, Ninety-third General Assembly, join unanimously to recognize the achievements of Jacob Highfill as a high school student athlete and to convey to him this legislative body's most heartfelt best wishes for continued personal, academic, and athletic success during his college years; and
