Whereas, the members of the Missouri House of Representatives hold in high esteem those Show-Me State residents who bring glory and honor to themselves and to this great state through the excellence of their achievements in their chosen fields of endeavor; and

Whereas, Reid Roberts has attained considerable distinction as a Firefighter and Emergency Medical Technician with the Cottleville Fire Protection District; and

Whereas, on Wednesday, July 13, 2005, Reid Roberts was given public accolades by the Cottleville Fire Protection District Board of Directors in light of his actions while on duty on June 21, 2005, when the crew of 8730 responded to assist the Augusta Fire Department with a house fire; and

Whereas, when Reid Roberts and his two firefighter team members heard radio reports concerning the fire in the neighboring district, they responded immediately instead of waiting to be officially dispatched to help; and

Whereas, upon arrival at the scene, Reid Roberts and his crew entered the home's basement to search for a man reportedly trapped by multiple explosions despite not knowing the cause of the explosions; and

Whereas, Reid Roberts and his crew used a Thermal Imaging Camera to locate the victim behind a door and under a sink and then quickly removed him from the house and into the care of paramedic crews; and

Whereas, the quick actions of Reid Roberts undoubtedly saved the life of John Kirsch, a local businessman, husband, and father; and

Whereas, Reid Roberts is the beloved husband of Katie Roberts and the loving father of five-year-old Bailey and three-year-old Brennen:

Now, therefore, be it resolved that we, the members of the Missouri House of Representatives, Ninety-third General Assembly, join unanimously to salute Reid Roberts and to convey to him this legislative body's most heartfelt commendation of his heroic actions on June 21, 2005, which saved the life of a fellow human being; and

Be it further resolved that the Chief Clerk of the Missouri House of Representatives be instructed to prepare a properly inscribed copy of this resolution for presentation to Reid Roberts of the Cottleville Fire Protection District.
