**Whereas**, Michael E. Henze has attained considerable distinction as the Chief Executive Officer of Lake Regional Health System, which was formerly known as Lake of the Ozarks General Hospital; and

**Whereas**, Michael Henze recently enhanced his already impressive record of achievement when he received the Visionary Leadership Award from the Missouri Hospital Association in light of his leading the way in expanding quality care within the Lake of the Ozarks region and its surrounding communities; and

**Whereas**, Michael Henze spearheaded the creation of a network of six health clinics, four rehabilitation therapy clinics, and three pharmacies as well as increasing hospital health screenings in the area of cardiac and prostate problems; and

**Whereas**, Michael Henze also has brought increased access to quality health care through such specialty care lines as cardiac and cancer treatment; and

**Whereas**, in addition to the construction of a cardiac catheterization laboratory and recruitment of cardiologists and a cardiovascular surgeon, Michael Henze helped raise funding for a linear accelerator for cancer patients who need radiation treatments through the newly-opened Center for Radiation Therapy; and

**Whereas**, during the ongoing tenure of Michael Henze as Chief Executive Officer, Lake Regional Health System also has been the first community hospital to receive a Missouri Quality Award and has enjoyed seeing its Lake Regional Hospital Auxiliary named Auxiliary of the Year multiple times by the Missouri Hospital Association:
