**Whereas**, the members of the Missouri House of Representatives pause to recognize the late Albert Hackmann, who will be inducted posthumously into the St. Charles Amateur Sports Hall of Fame during a special ceremony to be held March 10, 2007, at the American Legion Post 312 in St. Charles; and

**Whereas**, Albert Hackmann spent most of his life on or around the ballfield, earning recognition as an excellent first baseman who played for St. Paul in the East Missouri Hard Road League from 1937 to 1950; and

**Whereas**, asked to try out for the St. Louis Cardinals in 1942, Albert Hackmann always demonstrated leadership and sportsmanship to his team, both on and off the field; and

**Whereas**, following his retirement from active play, Albert Hackmann continued his leadership role and was the manager of the St. Paul Hard Road Team from 1950 to 1965 and the Girls' Softball Team from 1948 to 1956; and

**Whereas**, through Albert Hackmann's efforts, the St. Paul Baseball Team held together for many years as a competitive team that won several championships:

**Now, therefore, be it resolved** that we, the members of the Missouri House of Representatives, Ninety-fourth General Assembly, join in recognizing the achievements of the late Albert Hackmann; and

**Be it further resolved** that the Chief Clerk of the Missouri House of Representatives be instructed to prepare a properly inscribed copy of this resolution in honor of the late Albert Hackmann.
