**Whereas**, Lloyd Pelfrey also deserves mention of his service during the 1970s on the local Community Betterment Committee and of his service as president of Kiwanis; and

**Whereas**, married to his beloved Irene for fifty years, Lloyd Pelfrey is justifiably proud also to be known as the beloved father of Rhonda Dunham of Moberly; Theda Wortman of Atlanta, Georgia; and Brenda Bernhardt of Macon, Missouri:
