Whereas, Missouri State Representative Michael Frame will soon retire from the Northwest R-I School District Board of Education and will be honored at a ceremony to be held on April 12, 2007, at Northwest Valley School in House Springs, Missouri; and

Whereas, Michael Frame, a resident of Eureka, is the Union Representative for Service Employees International Union in addition to the Missouri State Representative for the 105th District, a member of the American Legion, the Ancient Free & Accepted Masons, Jefferson County Labor Club, Rockwood Labor Club, Delegate to the St. Louis Labor Council, Meramec/High Ridge Democratic Township Club, and the Missouri Democratic Party; and

Whereas, Michael Frame is the past recipient of a Presidential commendation upon being selected Military Leader of the Year in 1986, Chairman of the Missouri House-Freshman Democratic Caucus, and Deputy Minority Whip in the Missouri House of Representatives; and

Whereas, Michael Frame was elected to the Northwest R-I School District Board of Education in 2004 and was immediately elected to the position of Treasurer and was re-elected by his fellow board members in 2005 and 2006; and

Whereas, in 2006, the Northwest R-I School District Board of Education was recognized by the Missouri School Board Association as one of the top five outstanding school boards in our state; and

Whereas, Michael Frame has stood as a firm advocate and a guiding force for raising teacher salaries and teacher accountability in the Northwest R-I School District, and during his tenure, student achievement has increased, drop-out rates and student disciplinary matters have decreased, and MAP scores in most categories are at all-time district high levels; and

Whereas, Michael Frame was a strong proponent of the A+ Schools program and worked with board members to bring this program to the Northwest R-I School District, and as a result of the hard work and forward thinking, many Northwest students are attending institutions of higher learning that could not otherwise have attended; and

Whereas, Michael Frame is the son of Ronald and Shirley Frame, who live on in his memory, the beloved father of Savannah Frame, and devoted brother of Roger Frame and Diana Clark:

Now, therefore, be it resolved that we, the members of the Missouri House of Representatives, Ninety-fourth General Assembly, extend our best wishes to Missouri State Representative Michael Frame on the occasion of his retirement from the Northwest R-I School District Board; and
