Whereas, Donna Lichtenegger, of Jackson, Missouri, has been honored with the Bill Emerson Award; and

Whereas, Donna Lichtenegger has a long and distinguished record as a political volunteer, which began in 1974 when she worked in John Ashcroft's first campaign; and

Whereas, Donna Lichtenegger's volunteer career includes serving as the 2006 co-chair for the Talent for Senate campaign in the Eighth Congressional District and co-chair of the George W. Bush Presidential campaigns in 2000 and 2004, also in the Eighth Congressional District; and

Whereas, Donna Lichtenegger has marched in many parades with Bill and Joan Emerson, every year for twenty years, as she has worked in each and every one of the campaigns; and

Whereas, among her many activities, Donna Lichtenegger served from 1994 to 2000 as the Chairman of the Eighth Congressional District Committee, from 1994 to the present as a Member of the Republican State Committee representing Senatorial District 27; from 2000 to the present as Secretary of the 157th State Representative Committee; from 1994 to the present as Vice Chairman of the District 27 Senatorial Committee; from 1994 to the present as Chairman of the 32nd Circuit Judicial Committee; and from 1990 to the present as Committeewoman Byrd 1 Jackson, Missouri; and

Whereas, in the year 2000 alone, Donna Lichtenegger served as the Delegate to the Republican National Convention; Delegate and Eighth District Caucus Chair for the State Republican Caucus Convention; as a Member of the Rules Committee for the State Republican Caucus Convention; as the Eighth Congressional District Caucus Chairman; as the Eighth Congressional District Chairman of the Rules and Platform Committee; was elected Delegate to the Eighth Congressional and State Caucus Conventions from Cape Girardeau County; and

Whereas, apart from her political volunteer activities, Donna Lichtenegger has a long and distinguished record as a civic volunteer including her present service to the Southeast Missouri State University Symphony Advisory Board, Lutheran Family and Children's Services Board, and Lutherans for Life; and

Whereas, a qualified dental hygienist, Donna Lichtenegger has taken two significant trips to visit South America to start dental-hygiene programs:
