

House Resolution No. 1051

Whereas, the members of the Missouri House of Representatives feel it is altogether fitting and proper to pause from time to time to recognize individuals and organizations that have contributed to the welfare of this great state and its citizens; and

Whereas, Vincent Gregory Rouse, of Clinton, Missouri, will receive the prestigious rank of Eagle Scout during a Court of Honor ceremony to be held on March 11, 2007, at the Clinton Christian Church, in Clinton; and

Whereas, Vincent Gregory Rouse, a member of Boy Scout Troop 225, successfully met the requirements to attain Eagle status by completing his Eagle project and meeting all other criteria; and

Whereas, Vincent Gregory Rouse's Eagle project consisted of sanding, priming, painting and installing two large bike racks, six feet by five feet and intended for Katy Trail bike riders to use while visiting downtown Clinton, for Clinton Main Street and the Clinton Chamber of Commerce, a project that required 112 hours, five scout volunteers and three adult volunteers; and

Whereas, in his six years of scouting, Vincent Gregory Rouse has to his credit forty-three merit badges; and

Whereas, Vincent Gregory Rouse has demonstrated all of the leadership and character attributes required for holding the offices of Assistant Patrol Leader, Patrol Leader, Assistant Senior Patrol Leader and Senior Patrol Leader; and

Whereas, Vincent Gregory Rouse has participated in seven different camporees, including those held at the H. Roe Bartle Summer Camp and is an Ordeal Member of the Order of the Arrow; Foxman, Brave, Warrior, Firebuilder and Tom Tom Beater in the Tribe of Mic-O-Say with the name of Night Hawk of the Stormy Moon; seven years of Quality Unit and National Camping Awards; the Heritage Award; the Pop Corn Award; and World Conservation Award; and

Whereas, Vincent Gregory Rouse, son of Vincent and Deborah Rouse, realizes that the Eagle rank will be recognized at all levels of our society as being a great achievement that requires considerable dedication and effort:

Now, therefore, be it resolved that we, the members of the Missouri House of Representatives, Ninety-fourth General Assembly, extend our congratulations to Vincent Gregory Rouse and wish him every success in all his future endeavors; and

Be it further resolved that the Chief Clerk of the Missouri House of Representatives be instructed to prepare a properly inscribed copy of this resolution for presentation to Eagle Scout Vincent Gregory Rouse.
