**Whereas**, a member of the National Association of Broadcasters, Missouri Broadcasters, and the National Radio Advertising Bureau, Kenneth Meyer is the founder and president of Meyer Communications, director and past vice president of Cox Hospital, a board member of the Cox Hospital Foundation, director of Boys and Girls Town of Missouri, a board member of the Council of Churches Foundation, president of the Mount Vernon High School Foundation, director and past president of the MSU Foundation, past regent of Southwest Baptist University, president of Covenant Foundation, an elder at Covenant Presbyterian Church, president of the Ken and Jane Meyer Foundation, and a national board member of Students In Free Enterprise; and

**Whereas**, Kenneth Meyer has made numerous capital gifts to such institutions of higher education as Westminster College, Southwest Baptist University, and Missouri State University and has financially supported the Hammons Hall for the Performing Arts, Council of Churches, MSU Band, Salvation Army, Alzheimer's Association, American Heart Institute, MSU Tent Theatre, and MSU Band Veterans Day Salute:
