

## House Resolution No. 1742

**Whereas**, the members of the Missouri House of Representatives always welcome the opportunity to acknowledge milestone events in the lives of Show-Me State residents who have proven down through the years to be exemplary citizens in local communities and neighborhoods; and

**Whereas**, Detective Richard Tiemann will attain considerable distinction when he is presented with a 2006 Law Enforcement Officer of the Year Award from the Saint Charles Crime Stoppers organization at its annual Citizens of the Year Award Banquet, which will be held on April 19, 2007, at the Stegton Regency Banquet and Conference Center in Saint Charles, Missouri; and

**Whereas**, Detective Richard Tiemann will be given well-deserved honors and accolades for his role as a Detective with the Saint Charles Police Department; and

**Whereas**, a thirty-year police veteran, Detective Richard Tiemann was one of the first policemen trained and assigned to the Road I.D. Officers Unit, which processes crime scenes by collecting evidence, identifies suspects through fingerprints, and provides written reports; and

**Whereas**, thanks in large measure to the willingness of Detective Richard Tiemann to be an exemplary police officer, the Saint Charles Police Department is training new generations of Road I.D. Officers through the knowledge, skills, and experiences of those who served before; and

**Whereas**, Crime Stoppers is a national organization that was founded in 1976 to promote citizen assistance in the solving of crimes by publicizing criminal cases, offering anonymity to people who provide information about crimes, and paying rewards when information leads to arrest; and

**Whereas**, it is fitting and proper that the Missouri House of Representatives should pause in its diverse legislative endeavors in order to recognize such outstanding Missouri citizens as Detective Richard Tiemann at momentous times in their lives:

**Now, therefore, be it resolved** that we, the members of the Missouri House of Representatives, Ninety-fourth General Assembly, join unanimously to applaud Detective Richard Tiemann's success in working for the Saint Charles Police Department and to convey to him this legislative body's most heartfelt congratulations upon his receipt of a 2006 Law Enforcement Officer of the Year Award from the Saint Charles Crime Stoppers organization; and
