Whereas, the members of the Missouri House of Representatives always welcome the opportunity to acknowledge milestone events in the lives of Show-Me State residents who have proven down through the years to be exemplary citizens in local communities and neighborhoods; and

Whereas, John Richard Dengler will attain considerable distinction when he is presented with a 2006 Business of the Year Award from the Saint Charles Crime Stoppers organization at its annual Citizens of the Year Award Banquet, which will be held on April 19, 2007, at the Stegton Regency Banquet and Conference Center in Saint Charles, Missouri; and

Whereas, John Dengler will be given well-deserved honors and accolades in light of his ownership of the oldest family-owned tobacco shop in the country, John Dengler Tobacconist, Incorporated, and his generous leadership and support for the Saint Charles Mounted Police Foundation, which he has served as a member of the Board of Governors since 2000; and

Whereas, John Dengler also deserves mention of his additional service with the Project Area Committee of the Land Clearance for Redevelopment Authority, South Main Preservation Society, Lewis and Clark Heritage Days, Landmarks Preservation Board, Civil War Living History Days, Christmas Traditions, Special Business District Board, Saint Charles Lewis and Clark Bicentennial Commission, Saint Charles Chamber of Commerce, Discovery Expedition of Saint Charles, and the Lewis and Clark Fife and Drum Corps; and
