

House Resolution No. 1459

Whereas, the members of the Missouri House of Representatives always welcome the opportunity to recognize young men who have excelled during their association with the Boy Scouts of America program with its emphasis on physical, mental, and spiritual growth; self-reliance; personal values; service to others; and an appreciation and understanding of the wonderful natural world; and

Whereas, Christopher Wayne Mueller of Troop 397 has successfully completed all of the stringent requirements for Scouting's highest advancement award, the rank of Eagle Scout, which will be bestowed upon him during an Eagle Court of Honor on April 22, 2007 at Community Covenant Church in Kearney, Missouri; and

Whereas, attainment of the Eagle Scout rank is dependent upon the sequential completion of each of the Boy Scout steps of Tenderfoot, Second Class, First Class, Star, and Life, and expected troop service, a requirement admirably fulfilled by Christopher through the billets of Librarian, Patrol Leader, and Troop Guide; and

Whereas, diligent labors by Christopher earned him induction into the Order of the Arrow Brotherhood, Brave status in the Tribe of Mic-O-Say, First Aid and CPR certification, a Top Gun Award, the H. Roe Bartle heritage Award, and thirty-two merit badges that are arrayed on his uniform sash as a visual illustration of the diverse skills and knowledge which he has acquired as a Boy Scout; and

Whereas, in keeping with Scouting practice, Christopher applied the knowledge that he learned at troop meetings in many camping, hiking, and service activities, including four sessions at Bartle Scout Camp; and

Whereas, Christopher completed an Eagle Project that consisted of painting fire hydrants in Kearney to serve as a capstone to his Scouting career and to stand as a constant reminder of his dedication to serving others, an admirable trait that justifies the esteemed role which Scouting plays in today's society:

Now, therefore, be it resolved that we, the members of the Missouri House of Representatives, Ninety-fourth General Assembly, join unanimously to applaud the outstanding achievements realized by Christopher Mueller during his eleven-year-long sojourn with Scouting and to congratulate him for having the drive and energy necessary to attain the rank of Eagle; and

Be it further resolved that the Chief Clerk of the Missouri House of Representatives be instructed to prepare a properly inscribed copy of this resolution for new Eagle Scout Christopher Wayne Mueller, son of Brad and Doris Mueller.
