

## House Resolution No. 1810

**Whereas**, the members of the Missouri House of Representatives hold in high esteem those Show-Me State residents who have contributed an exceptional amount of time and energy to helping students obtain the knowledge, skills, and experiences necessary to become lifelong learners, involved citizens, and future societal leaders; and

**Whereas**, Skipper Maybee of Seymour, Missouri, has attained considerable distinction as an educator in the Fordland R-III School District, a vocational calling that she will draw to a close in May 2007 after twenty years of service; and

**Whereas**, Skipper Maybee has developed and maintained an exceptional reputation for her activities at the Seymour Church of Christ, with the Greater Seymour Area Foundation Board and the Parent Teacher Organization of Fordland, as a state trainer for Parents as Teachers, as a member of the planning committee for the Missouri Department of Elementary and Secondary Education's Conference on the Young Years, as an educational grant writer, and as the implementor of a local Dolly Parton Imagination Library for very young children; and

**Whereas**, no stranger to honors and accolades, Skipper Maybee is the recipient of an Early Childhood and Parent Education Distinguished Service Award presented by the Early Childhood Section of the Missouri Department of Elementary and Secondary Education and of an Outstanding Older Worker award for southwest Missouri from the Missouri Department of Health and Senior Services; and

**Whereas**, Skipper Maybee is justifiably proud also to be known as the loving mother of Amie and Brandon Frantz:

**Now, therefore, be it resolved** that we, the members of the Missouri House of Representatives, Ninety-fourth General Assembly, join unanimously to applaud the personal and professional accomplishments garnered down through the years by Skipper Maybee and to convey to her this legislative body's most heartfelt best wishes as she partakes of the special opportunities and pleasures traditionally associated with the golden years of retirement; and
