

House Resolution No. 1908

Whereas, the members of the Missouri House of Representatives hold in high esteem those Show-Me State governmental agencies that admirably are dedicated to improving quality of life in local communities and neighborhoods by ensuring that state services and programs are provided in the efficient, effective manner mandated by the public; and

Whereas, the Missouri Department of Corrections Maryville Treatment Center in Maryville, Missouri, has sponsored National Crime Victims Rights Week events in cooperation with the Missouri Board of Probation and Parole since 1996 when the Maryville Treatment Center was opened; and
