Whereas, in 1974 Larry Bingham joined Bill Burrell and Jim Seigfreid to form Burrell, Seigfreid and Bingham, which is now known as Seigfreid, Bingham, Levy, Selzer & Gee; and

Whereas, Larry Bingham retired as managing director in 2006, but continues to serve on the firm's executive committee; and

Whereas, Larry Bingham maintained a general corporate practice throughout his career in which he specialized in income, gift and estate tax, and succession planning issues for family-owned businesses; in transaction matters and other legal issues for corporations; and in tax-exempt issues for the health care industry:
