

House Resolution No. 2578

Whereas, the members of the Missouri House of Representatives hold in high esteem those Show-Me State residents who admirably have proven down through the years to be exemplary civic leaders in local communities and neighborhoods; and

Whereas, Eric Bradley Wiederhold of Bonne Terre, Missouri, has attained considerable distinction as the city administrator for Desloge, a leadership calling that he will draw to a close on May 4, 2007, after seven years of service; and

Whereas, during the tenure of Eric Wiederhold as city administrator, Desloge secured financing for the construction of an outer road on the eastern side of U.S. Highway 67, opened a new public safety building to house the police department, renovated the Miners Lumber Company building as the current city hall, planned the renovation and expansion of the public library, nearly completed phase one of the waterworks system, negotiated a 2001 Tax Increment Finance Authority Redevelopment Agreement that resulted in a 24-acre commercial subdivision anchored by a Wal-Mart Supercenter, and attracted such new businesses as an Auto Zone, Blockbuster, O'Reilly Auto Parts, Meinke Auto Center, Movie Gallery, and USA Drugs; and

Whereas, Eric Wiederhold prepared for his duties and responsibilities in city administration by earning Bachelor's and Master's degrees in business administration; and

Whereas, a veteran of the United States Marine Corps, Eric Wiederhold is a member of the International City/County Management Association, the Chamber of Commerce, and Rotary; and

Whereas, Eric Wiederhold is justifiably proud also to be known as the loving son of Wilma and Sam Wiederhold; and

Whereas, it is fitting and proper that the Missouri House of Representatives should pause in its diverse legislative activities in order to acknowledge milestone events in the lives and careers of such outstanding Missouri citizens as Eric Wiederhold:

Now, therefore, be it resolved that we, the members of the Missouri House of Representatives, Ninety-fourth General Assembly, join unanimously to applaud the personal and professional accomplishments garnered thus far in the life and work of Eric Wiederhold and to convey to him this legislative body's most heartfelt best wishes as he shifts the focus of his time and energy to other venues of service; and
