

House Resolution No. 2739

Whereas, the members of the Missouri House of Representatives hold in high esteem those Show-Me State residents who have contributed an exceptional amount of time and energy to ensuring that state government provides its much-needed services and programs in the efficient, effective manner mandated by the public; and

Whereas, Kathleen "Kay" Green of Jefferson City, Missouri, has attained considerable distinction as the Director of Federal Programs with the Missouri Department of Mental Health's Division of Mental Retardation/Developmental Disabilities, a leadership calling that she will draw to a close on May 31, 2007, after eighteen years of service; and

Whereas, formerly a Management Analysis Specialist I and Program Coordinator, Kay Green has administered a Targeted Case Management Program and three 1915 Medicaid Home and Community Based Waivers, which provide more than \$250 million in services to approximately 8,000 Missourians who have mental retardation and developmental disabilities; and

Whereas, a former Aging Program Specialist I with the Division of Aging, Missouri Department of Social Services, Kay Green also is a member of Concord Baptist Church; and

Whereas, Kay Green was active in the American Cancer Society from 1988 to 1992 and with the American Red Cross in 1993; and

Whereas, the beloved wife of Danny, Kay Green has two sons, one also named Danny and the other named Derek; and

Whereas, it is fitting and proper that the Missouri House of Representatives should pause in its diverse legislative endeavors in order to recognize such outstanding Missouri citizens as Kay Green at momentous times in their lives:

Now, therefore, be it resolved that we, the members of the Missouri House of Representatives, Ninety-fourth General Assembly, join unanimously to applaud the personal and professional accomplishments garnered in the life and career of Kay Green and to convey to her this legislative body's most heartfelt best wishes as she partakes of the special opportunities and pleasures traditionally associated with the golden years of retirement; and
