

## House Resolution No. 2636

**Whereas**, the son of Christopher and Jamie Cheshier, Ryan developed immense personal growth and fitness by participating in the many assorted activities the Boy Scouts offers, some of which include attending the North Star District Camporee, the North Star District Klondike Derby, and six summer camps at H. Roe Bartle Scout Reservation, where he worked on staff for two years; and

**Whereas**, Ryan's attainment of the Eagle rank will be recognized at all levels of our society as being a great achievement that required considerable dedication and effort:

**Now, therefore, be it resolved** that we, the members of the Missouri House of Representatives, Ninety-fourth General Assembly, join in extending our most hearty congratulations to Ryan Cheshier for the steadfast determination he displayed in his pursuit to attain the rank of Eagle and in wishing him continued success in all future endeavors; and
