

House Resolution No.

Whereas, the members of the Missouri House of Representatives enjoy a long, proud tradition of meeting their responsibilities to the citizens of this state while upholding the virtues represented by the “Glory of Missouri”: Knowledge, Liberty, Equality, Law, Justice, Fraternity, Education, Progress, Honor, Truth, Virtue, Temperance, Enterprise, and Charity; and

Whereas, these virtues are engraved in the House Chamber of the State Capitol with the inscription: “All the foregoing human qualities bind into one theme the Glory of Missouri because no people attain these virtues unless they are great”; and

Whereas, the “Glory of Missouri” virtues were engraved in the early 1920s under the direction of the Decorating Commission, which recognized their relevance and importance to the early Missouri Legislature; and

Whereas, Megan Kelly, a student at Mill Creek Elementary School, has been selected to receive the “Glory of Missouri” Award for accomplishments in the in the areas of KNOWLEDGE, LIBERTY, EQUALITY, LAW, JUSTICE, FRATERNITY, EDUCATION, PROGRESS, HONOR, TRUTH, VIRTUE, TEMPERANCE, ENTERPRISE, and CHARITY as these terms are defined by Webster’s dictionary of 1926:

Now, therefore, be it resolved that we, the members of the Missouri House of Representatives, Ninety-fourth General Assembly, unanimously join in commending Megan Kelly for noteworthy achievements in the pursuit of Missouri’s virtues, and in extending heartfelt congratulations at this proud moment of well-deserved distinction; and

Be it further resolved that the Chief Clerk of the Missouri House of Representatives be instructed to prepare a properly inscribed copy of this resolution for Megan Kelly.
