

House Resolution No. 3856

Whereas, the members of the Missouri House of Representatives feel it is altogether fitting and proper to pause from time to time to recognize individuals and organizations that have contributed to the welfare of this great state and its citizens; and

Whereas, the members now pause to recognize Paul Enke, Head Coach of the 2005 Fort Zumwalt South High School Cross-Country Bulldogs, who were the winners of the Class IV State Championship; and

Whereas, Paul Enke was assisted by Assistant Coach Joni Biehl; and

Whereas, Head Coach Paul Enke has an impressive five-year performance record of five hundred sixteen wins and seventy-eight losses, five conference championships, four district championships, two regional championships, and two state championships; and

Whereas, Paul Enke has an even more impressive thirty-four-season career record of two thousand four hundred ninety-five wins, four hundred ten loses, 27 conference championships, twenty-three district championships, ten regional championships, and three state championships; and

Whereas, Paul Enke was the 1986 Cross-Country Coach of the Year, a 2002 National Cross-Country Coach of the Year Finalist, the Missouri Cross-Country Coach of the Year for 2005 and again for 2006, and National Boys Cross-Country Coach of the Year for 2006; and

Whereas, the 2005 Fort Zumwalt South High School Cross-Country Bulldogs included Kyle Rood, Pat Cole, Brandon Funderburk, Ryan Moore, Scott Towers, Tyler Mullen, and Eric Schulte; and

Whereas, Fort Zumwalt South High School is a twenty-year-old school in St. Charles County, Missouri, with an administration and teaching staff of one hundred fifty, a student population of over two thousand in grades nine through twelve, and an average daily attendance of ninety-three per cent:

Now, therefore, be it resolved that we, the members of the Missouri House of Representatives, Ninety-fourth General Assembly, join to extend our congratulations to Head Coach Paul Enke and his 2005 Cross-Country Bulldogs on their stellar performance and commend them for being a credit to their families, friends, school, communities, and state; and
