Whereas, the Reverend G. Timothy Vowels, an esteemed resident of Chesterfield, Missouri, is celebrating the Thirtieth Anniversary of his Ordination to the priesthood of the Catholic Church; and

Whereas, a 1973 graduate of Saint Louis University, Father Vowels attended Kenrick Seminary from 1973 to 1977 and was ordained May 23, 1977, by Cardinal Carberry; and

Whereas, Father Vowels was assigned to Mary, Queen of Peace Parish in Webster Groves from 1977 to 1981, and Immaculate Heart of Mary Parish in St. Louis on a part-time basis from 1981 to 1989, during which time he also served as Associate Director of the Archdiocesan Mission Office; and

Whereas, Father Vowels blessed the congregations of Incarnate Word Parish as Associate Pastor from 1989 to 1993 and St. Martin de Porres Parish in Hazelwood as Pastor from 1993 to 2002 before joining Incarnate Word Parish in 2002; and

Whereas, Father Vowels is exceedingly proud of his affiliation with such important organizations as the Friends of the New Cathedral and Classical Languages Honor Society:
