Whereas, Lance Corporal Rex Arthur Page, of Kirksville, Missouri, gave the last full measure of his devotion after suffering fatal wounds during an attack on his unit in Fallujah, Iraq, on June 28, 2006; and

Whereas, Lance Corporal Rex Arthur Page was born on Christmas Eve, December 24, 1984, attended Kirksville Christian Elementary School and Christian High School, and he joined the Marines on May 2, 2005; and

Whereas, Lance Corporal Rex Arthur Page was a member of the United States Marines, 3rd Battalion, 5th Marines, 1st Platoon (Infantry); and

Whereas, Lance Corporal Rex Arthur Page was the recipient of the National Defense Medal, the Combat Action Ribbon, and the Purple Heart; and

Whereas, the loss of Lance Corporal Rex Arthur Page will be forever felt by his parents, Larry and Edie Page and his brother, James Page; and

Whereas, Lance Corporal Rex Arthur Page was the grandson of Marion A. And Edith J. Page and Prentiss R. And Augusta L. Brown, all of whom continue to live the memories of those who knew and loved them; and

Whereas, the Patriot Guard Riders and others will be returning to Kirksville to the New Hope Evangelical Church on Saturday, July 7, 2007, for an open house in honor of the sad occasion of the first anniversary of the tragic loss of Lance Corporal Rex Arthur Page:
