

## House Resolution No. 4433

**Whereas**, it is with tremendous pleasure that the members of the Missouri House of Representatives pause in their diverse daily activities in order to recognize Show-Me State residents who have proven down through the years to be exemplary citizens in local communities and neighborhoods; and

**Whereas**, Len Pagano of Saint Peters, Missouri, was elected in April 2007 to fill the unexpired term of former Mayor Shawn Brown; and

**Whereas**, since his election success, Mayor Len Pagano has devoted a tremendous amount of time and energy to fulfilling the lengthy list of projects appearing on his campaign platform, including the lawsuit brought by Saint Charles County and the Great Rivers Habitat Alliance, the development of the Premier 370 Business Park, wireless internet access at government buildings and city parks, improvements to the highway system in the county, and a changed agenda for city council meetings; and

**Whereas**, Mayor Len Pagano has developed and maintained an excellent reputation for appointing women to such venues of service as the city prosecuting attorney and the planning and zoning offices; and

**Whereas**, three additional projects focused on by Mayor Len Pagano include the town's fiftieth birthday as a fourth-class city, the centennial anniversary of the town's incorporation, and the creation of a history book; and

**Whereas**, Mayor Len Pagano also would like to see setting possible term limits, changing elected officials from four-year to three-year terms in office, opening up the possibility of part-time or full-time mayoral positions, and shifting from four wards to eight wards with one alderman per ward; and

**Whereas**, Mayor Len Pagano foresees a combination courtroom and Board of Alderman chamber at a new Justice Center approved by the voters, converting the current Board of Aldermen chamber into a performing arts facility, developing a restaurant and boat rental facility through a corporate sponsorship plan, and speeding up development of a Greenways Network park:

**Now, therefore, be it resolved** that we, the members of the Missouri House of Representatives, Ninety-fourth General Assembly, join unanimously to applaud the election of Len Pagano as Mayor of the city of Saint Peters and to convey to him this legislative body's most heartfelt congratulations for the success he has enjoyed during his first one hundred days in office; and

**Be it further resolved** that the Chief Clerk of the Missouri House of Representatives be instructed to prepare a properly inscribed copy of this resolution for presentation to Len Pagano of Saint Peters, Missouri.
