

House Resolution No. 4583

Whereas, the members of the Missouri House of Representatives were truly saddened by the death of Corporal Jessy G. Pollard on August 22, 2007, while on active duty at Multaka, Iraq, participating in Operation Iraqi Freedom; and

Whereas, born on December 30, 1984, Jessy Pollard was the son of Patty Joe Dewitt of Ozark, Missouri, and Guy Stirman Pollard, III, of Lansing, Michigan; and

Whereas, a former Army Specialist, Jessy Pollard was posthumously promoted to Corporal and awarded the Bronze Star Medal and the Army Good Conduct Medal; and

Whereas, Jessy Pollard had previously earned the National Defense Service Medal, Iraq Campaign Medal, Global War on Terrorism Service Medal, Noncommissioned Officers Professional Development Ribbon, Army Service Ribbon, Overseas Service Ribbon and Rifle Weapons Qualification Badge; and

Whereas, the members of the Missouri House of Representatives paused in silence on August 23, 2007, in honor of fallen soldier Jessy Pollard:

Now, therefore, be it resolved that we, the members of the Missouri House of Representatives, Ninety-fourth General Assembly, join unanimously to memorialize the life and service of Jessy Pollard and to convey this legislative body's most heartfelt condolences to his family members, friends, neighbors, and colleagues who now miss his considerable warmth, strength, and light in their daily lives; and

Be it further resolved that the Chief Clerk of the Missouri House of Representatives be instructed to prepare a properly inscribed copy of this resolution in memory of Corporal Jessy G. Pollard of the United States Army.
