AN ACT

To amend chapter 290, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to minimum wage law.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Chapter 290, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new section, to be
2 known as section 290.531, to read as follows:

3 **290.531. The department of labor and industrial relations shall promulgate rules**
4 **to implement the provisions of sections 290.500 to 290.530. Any rule or portion of a rule,**
5 **as that term is defined in section 536.010, RSMo, that is created under the authority**
6 **delegated in this section shall become effective only if it complies with and is subject to all**
7 **of the provisions of chapter 536, RSMo, and, if applicable, section 536.028, RSMo. This**
8 **section and chapter 536, RSMo, are nonseverable and if any of the powers vested with the**
9 **general assembly under chapter 536, RSMo, to review, to delay the effective date, or to**
10 **disapprove and annul a rule are subsequently held unconstitutional, then the grant of**
rulemaking authority and any rule proposed or adopted after August 28, 2008, shall be
invalid and void.
