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## AN ACT

To amend chapter 9, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to the designation of parent and family involvement in education week.

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*Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:*

Section A. Chapter 9, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new section, to be  
2 known as section 9.139, to read as follows:

**9.139. The governor shall annually issue a proclamation setting apart the second  
2 week of September as "Parent and Family Involvement in Education Week", and  
3 recommending to the people of the state that the week be appropriately observed through  
4 activities that will bring about an increased awareness of the importance and benefits of  
5 parent and family involvement in education and encourage greater involvement of parents  
6 and families in their children's education, both in the school and in the home. The parent  
7 and family involvement in education week recognizes that parent and family involvement**

EXPLANATION — Matter enclosed in bold-faced brackets [thus] in the above bill is not enacted and is intended to be omitted from the law. Matter in **bold-face** type in the above bill is proposed language.

8 **in a child's education is a major factor in determining success in school, regardless of the**  
9 **socio-economic status, race, or ethnic background of the family, or the education level of**  
10 **the parents.**

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
