Whereas, the members of the Missouri House of Representatives are fully cognizant of the important role which the Boy Scouts of America organization plays in offering a well-rounded program of activities designed to prepare young men for the many diverse challenges of responsible citizenship; and; and

Whereas, Daniel Castro will receive the prestigious rank of Eagle Scout during a Court of Honor ceremony to be held on February 5, 2008; and

Whereas, Daniel Castro, the son of Grace Hertel and a member of Boy Scout Troop 374, successfully met the requirements to attain Eagle status by completing his Eagle project and meeting all other criteria; and

Whereas, Daniel Castro's Eagle project consisted of designing, planning, and creating a gravel path with stepping stones at Francis Howell North, a path approximately one hundred feet long which provided a safe, dry walk-way for the students, faculty, and staff leading from the school's library to the parking lot; and

Whereas, in his eight years of scouting, Daniel Castro has earned twenty-two merit badges and demonstrated all the skills and attributes required to hold the offices of Patrol Leader, Assistant Senior Patrol Leader, and Senior Patrol Leader; and

Whereas, Daniel Castro is the proud holder of the Minute Man Knot and the Recruiter Award, and he has 137 nights of camping, over 200 miles of hiking – including all seven trails in Shiloh, Tennessee, two High Adventure trips to the Great Northwest, and has attended Philmont; and

Whereas, Daniel Castro earned his Eagle Scout status in the summer of 2007, and he currently attends a technical school in Arizona; and

Whereas, Daniel Castro realizes that the Eagle rank will be recognized at all levels of our society as being a great achievement that requires considerable dedication and effort:

Now, therefore, be it resolved that we, the members of the Missouri House of Representatives, Ninety-fourth General Assembly, extend our congratulations to Daniel Castro and wish him every success in all his future endeavors; and
