

House Resolution No. 675

Whereas, it is with utmost respect that the members of the Missouri House of Representatives pause in their daily legislative endeavors in order to recognize those Show-Me State residents who truly embody the concept of Outstanding Missourian through their deeds and achievements; and

Whereas, Kattesh V. Katti, M.D. of Columbia, Missouri, has attained considerable distinction as a professor of radiology and physics at the University of Missouri-Columbia and as the Director of its Nanoparticles Production Core and Bioconjugation Core Facility; and

Whereas, on March 4, 2008, Dr. Kattesh Katti will meet with state legislators in the Missouri House of Representatives to receive well-deserved honors and accolades for the exemplary role he has performed in Missouri as a community leader; and

Whereas, Dr. Kattesh Katti prepared for his lifelong endeavors by earning a Bachelor of Science degree in chemistry from Karnatak University, a Master of Science Education degree from the University of Mysore, and a Doctor of Philosophy degree in inorganic chemistry from the Indian Institute of Science; and

Whereas, Dr. Kattesh Katti continued his education as a research associate at the University of Alberta and as an Alexander von Humboldt Fellow at the Institute of Inorganic Chemistry at the University of Göttingen; and

Whereas, Dr. Kattesh Katti has more than twenty years experience in the application of chemical conjugates for the design and development of pharmaceutical precursors, cancer diagnostics, therapeutic agents, biosensors, and functionalized materials and biomaterials derived from non-metals, metals, radiometals, and nanometal precursors; and

Whereas, Dr. Kattesh Katti joined the University of Missouri-Columbia in 1990 and is the principal investigator of the recently funded Cancer Nanotechnology Platform Partnership titled "Hybrid Nanoparticles In Imaging and Therapy of Prostate Cancer":
