

House Resolution No. 888

Whereas, the members of the Missouri House of Representatives occasionally find it their solemn duty to acknowledge the passing away of such outstanding Missouri residents as Samuel Jeffrey "Jeff" Overlease of Lee's Summit; and

Whereas, a Senior Consultant for NexGenisys with additional responsibilities at Saint Joseph Medical Center, Jeff Overlease was a Registered Pharmacist and the holder of a Master of Business Administration degree; and

Whereas, Jeff Overlease proudly served as a pharmacist with a Missouri Disaster Medical Assistance Team and a Federal Disaster Medical Team; was a member of the Mid America Medical Reserve Corps, Mid America Regional Council Regional Homeland Security Coordinating Committees, Missouri Strategic National Stockpile Advisory Council, Missouri Society of Health System Pharmacists, American Society of Health System Pharmacists, and Greater Kansas City Society of Health System Pharmacists; and was an adult leader for Cub Scout Pack 323; and

Whereas, after the events of September 11, 2001, Jeff Overlease volunteered his time and energy to regional homeland security efforts and proved to be instrumental in regional and statewide planning, education, and exercises and in the unprecedented collaboration between Kansas City area hospitals during a state exercise designed to test emergency response plans if a biological agent was released; and

Whereas, Jeff Overlease is survived by his beloved wife, Jennifer Overlease, and his loving children, Sarah Overlease and Kyle Overlease; and

Whereas, it is fitting and proper that the Missouri House of Representatives should pause in its diverse legislative actions in order to give posthumous recognition to citizens such as Jeff Overlease, who have made innumerable contributions to their professions, hometowns, state, and nation:

Now, therefore, be it resolved that we, the members of the Missouri House of Representatives, Ninety-fourth General Assembly, join unanimously to memorialize the life and work of Jeff Overlease and to convey this legislative body's most heartfelt condolences to his family members, colleagues, friends, and neighbors who now miss his considerable strength, warmth, and light in their daily lives; and

Be it further resolved that the Chief Clerk of the Missouri House of Representatives be instructed to prepare a properly inscribed copy of this resolution in memory of Samuel Jeffrey "Jeff" Overlease of Lee's Summit, Missouri.
